
## REFLECTIONS (FLIPS)

Practice reflecting across a diagonal (slanted \ or /) line below. It may help to turn your book so the mirror line is horizontal — or vertical |).




## MIRROR WRITING

Then, look at them in the mirror!


56. Draw a reflection of the letter G.




57. Draw a reflection of the letter W.




58. Draw a reflection of the letter R.




59. Draw a reflection of the letter K.




60. On the left, draw your first and last initials. Draw their reflection on the right.
